Approval of previous minutes by K. Laso, seconded by E. Holst

New Business

Voting member list: attendance taken

SAC there were 38 classes last year this year there are 34 classes to distribute the state awarded money \$5,213.90 and divide that by 34 instead of 38

Elizabeth Holst motioned to have a vote to split among all the teachers at Tildenville, so equal amount among classes.

There will be a vote among the voting members this week

Principal's report:

- Thermometers were purchased for temperature checks; they have to be used for forehead
- Data: iReady testing completed on LaunchEd and Face to Face
- Reading percentages
 - K - 42 to 51 (64 to 37 below grade level)
 - 1 - 32 to 41 (48 to 44 below grade level)
 - 2 - 42 to 30 (33 to 43 below grade level)
 - 3 - 60 to 39 (17 to 17 below grade level)
 - 4 - 42 to 31 (23 to 29 below grade level)
 - 5 - 39 to 31 (21 to 14 below grade level)

Significant drop in levels for third through fifth grade; parents please help with some extra support at home. Have students practice iReady

Math percentages

- K -31 to 34 (74 to 55 below grade level)
- 1 - 15 - 25 (65 to 57 below grade level)
- 2 - 25 to 11 (51 to 54 below grade level)
- 3 - 27 to 10 (53 to 43 below grade level)
- 4 - 34 to 23 (28 to 41 below grade level)
- 5 - 36 to 32 (30 to 23 below grade level)

- Switching instructional models from Face to Face to LaunchEd or vice versa there is no guarantee that your student will have the same teacher. The deadline to submit paperwork is Friday September 18. It will take effect on October 13
- It is possible that there might be a change in teacher even if you keep your choice the same.
- Between Oct 5 and 9 parents will be notified of any changes.

New Business:

- Vote on SAC Bylaws for 2020-2021-approved by 19 members who were present.
- Specials grades: art and music participation grade only, no assignments so far
- Suggestions to close the gap from Face2Face students and LaunchEd:
 - Weekly newsletters for what standards and what is being taught
 - Advance notice of materials needed for activities at home, for example PE
 - Vocabulary and passages given ahead of time for dual language
 - Providing pictures of charts in class to LaunchEd students
 - Optional practice problems for home review
 - Specific time each week to allow students to express concerns with their work
- Textbooks will be transitioned to digital in the future
- Workbooks are digital. If a paper copy is sent home, it must be graded

Proposal for School Recognition Award Money

To Go Back to School

This proposal is regarding the \$5213.90 from the Grade Recognition Award money received in the 2019-2020 school year. This money has not yet been disbursed as of 9/16/20, due to the disruption of face to face classes in March 2020.

The proposal approved by SAC in November 2019 reads as follows:

Back to school (split among ALL full-time teachers in grades PK, K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, ESE, & Specials – 38 classrooms):

\$5,213.90 ÷ 38 = \$137.20 per classroom (38 classrooms X \$137.20 = 5,213.60; 0.30¢ leftover; All items purchased must be from a school approved vendor and become the property of the school. If a teacher leaves Tildenville, the items stay at the school. Items must be used for instruction and educational purposes only. Furniture and decorations are not considered educational items. All items will be inventoried).

Currently, Tildenville has 35 classrooms (including PK, K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, ESE, & Specials). We are voting to approve a new distribution of these monies as follows:

Back to school (split among ALL current 2020-2021 Full -time teachers in grades PK, K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, ESE, & Specials – 35 classrooms):

\$5,213.90 ÷ 35 = \$148.96 per classroom (35 classrooms X \$148.96 = 5,213.60; 0.30¢ leftover; All items purchased must be from a school approved vendor and become the property of the school. If a teacher leaves Tildenville, the items stay at the school. Items must be used for instruction and educational purposes only. Furniture and decorations are not considered educational items. All items will be inventoried).

Vote was held digitally on 9/18/20. Approved by 18 out of 26 members. 8 members did not vote. Therefore, the vote on the proposal is approved by a 69% majority vote. (Members in agreement: J.
