Principal's report

Reading

Kindergarten 40-75
First grade from 38 to 59%
Second 46- 67%
Third 69-76%
Fourth 55-59%
Fifth 47-49%

Math

Kindergarten 28-54%
First 18-48%
Second 28-49%
Third 31-52%
Fourth 46-65%
Fifth 41-52%

- Students need help with math facts and fluency
- Students need to use the strategies for math and reading problems
I.E., If the question is asking something like choose 2 and they only choose 1 then they will get question wrong.
- Use “slash to trash” slash out the words that they don't need in the question.

Incentives: i-Ready pass lessons with highest completion %

iStation report

- gives 3 tiers just like iReady
- Mrs. Alvarez didn't share results because they were individualized.
