New Business 8/20/19

1. Remind – We were informed that Remind is an outgoing format only and parents should handle any questions/issues directly with their child’s teacher.

2. Testing – Testing is to begin next week, 8/27/19, for the following tests:
 - AR – Kindergarten through 5th
 - Istation – Kindergarten through 5th, dual language students only
 - Iready – Kindergarten through 5th
 - Phonics – Kindergarten
 - Write Score – Kindergarten through 5th
 - LAS Linx Spanish readings – Kindergarten through 2nd, DL students

Teachers will share results with parents

3. Principal’s Report:
 - 2nd grade teacher, Ms. Kirk has started
 - Kindergarten teacher, Ms. A, scheduled to start tomorrow 8/21
 - Paraprofessional position is posted
 - School student count is currently 555 + 40 VPK students.
 - Scheduling is still in progress. There will be no more class movements that have not already been approved.
 - Alvarez is contact for Skyward, however contact information can be updated by Registrar.
 - Moving specials times to permit earlier dismissal of 5th graders was discussed, but is not an option.
 - School Budget will require an extra \$150,000 approximately for extra teachers which were not previously planned.
 - New IT person on staff, Justin Johnson.

4. Marquee funds allocation:
 - An option to use the funds to pay for library mural was discussed. 2 different artists are available. A voting member list will be created by Alvarez and allocation of marquee funds for library mural will be scheduled for a vote at next SAC meeting on 9/17/19.
 - Tablecloths, runners, and Cricut accessories will be purchased from donated funds from 2018-2019 school year.

5. Voting member list – A list of interested voting members was created from attendees of current meeting to be used to finalize a Voting Member List. Voting Member List must represent school community demographics. Voting members can only miss 1 SAC meeting for the 2019-2020 school year, but must attend all others. SAC meetings are scheduled for the 3rd Tuesday of every month.
6. Assistant Principal – School must have 650 full time enrolled students.
7. SAC relationship with teachers – SAC will reach out to lead teachers in each grade level and special areas to determine the needs of the students and teachers and determine how SAC can provide help.
8. Clubs:
 - Clubs will start Monday, 8/27/19.
 - Media center will be reserved for Kindergarten and 1st grade only for the first week.
 - Running club and Media center club need volunteers. Opportunities will be posted on the Additions site.
9. Green school: School will continue to recycle and brainstorm ideas to obtain Green School status. J. Scheffer agreed to help with application.
