

## **SAC minutes**

### **September 17, 2019**

4:01 called to order by Joanna Mosby

Asked everyone to look over minutes from last meeting and approve them

Ms. Black moved to approve minutes; second by Juliet Scheffer

#### **1. Report from Julie Hager:**

- Testing is just about done, kindergarten will be next week
- Kindergarten is almost done with FLKRS. It is getting scores from Pre-school as well
- I- station parent night tomorrow September 18 at 5:30p
- STAR gives independent reading level
- Library has labeled books with AR levels
- There will be points charts for AR, and possibility to get prizes
- Science benchmark testing on bubble sheets
- LAS first and second grade test, speaking, reading, and writing in Spanish
- Book fair - October 7-11
- Hispanic Heritage Night will be October 10 from 5:30 to 7 (snacks and activities)
- Red Ribbon week 21st through the 25th
- Remind App for whole school is working

#### **2. Safety at car loop; teachers are concerned that there are parents that are not being safe. Such as running over cones:**

- Deputy Threat can't enforce cars being turned off during car line
- Study was done to have the double car line
- Deputy Threat requested a second officer during that time, but has been denied
- Teachers would like two heavy duty cones to have at the beginning of the car line
- Juliet suggested that every teacher get their own safety vest
- Kindergarten parents might not have gotten flier describing car line procedures. Whenever a new parent gets a car loop tag then a flier needs to be attached

- Maybe someone from county needs to come out and reevaluate the flow of car line
- Ms. Black suggested having younger students go to older sibling's pole.
- Principal Alvarez said she's visited schools that have screw in poles
- Parents need to call 311 to ask that Brick Road be designated a one way road during dismissal time

**3. Concern came up about communication during an emergency situation; principal could not disclose specific information due to the nature of incident**

- There will be a generic message sent. If there is something wrong with a specific child then that parent will be notified. If it involves all students then a more specific message will be sent

**4. Principal's report**

- One open position for a front desk person part time, all teaching positions filled
- 611 students currently
- Zero dollars in debt
- \$30,000 left for supplies and subs
- 12 day count states if school met projections
- October is second FTE, first count to see who will count to FSA for school grade; and rest of the funding for the school year
- Feb is another count to see projection for next year
